## Services Provided

Provide wrap-around assistance and stability for Re-entry clients in the following areas:

- Job searching and job skills development
- Direct referral to employers
- Educational goals
- Transportation assistance
- Transitional Housing assistance
- Coordination of Mental Health/ Substance Abuse Treatment

## Goal

We strive to reduce recidivism in terms of failure to appear, new arrest, and parole violation with individuals post-conviction/post-incarceration through increasing access to employment, housing, transportation and education

## Eligibility

Participation in the Re-entry Services program is voluntary. Any individual returning to Buncombe County from incarceration in prison.

## Referrals

Many clients are referred through the courts, law enforcement, attorneys, community supervision and area service providers

We accept self-referrals on a case by case basis.
